Arrest Made in Incline Suspicious Death Case

Washoe County Sheriff's Detectives, with the help of United States Marshals, have arrested Mary Arlayne Baymiller, 73, in connection to the stabbing death of her husband Charles Alan Baymiller, which occurred in October at their residence in Incline Village.

Baymiller was at her residence in Fresno, California when Marshals took her into custody. She is charged with Murder with a Deadly Weapon.

The case began October 5th, 2009, when Washoe County Deputies responded, at the request of a family member, to check the welfare of the elderly couple. At approximately 8:00PM, deputies arrived at the condo and located Charles deceased, the victim of an apparent stabbing.

Mary was unconscious and needing medical assistance. She was transported by Care Flight to the Renown Medical Center for treatment. After her release she returned to her residence in Fresno where she was taken into custody today.

Should she agree to sign a waiver of extradition, Baymiller would be transported to Reno in the next few weeks.
