The Washoe County Sheriff's Office, Reno Police Department and Sparks Police Department Repeat Offender Program in conjunction with the Lyon County Sheriff's Office arrested two people and charged them for recent home burglaries in the Reno/Sparks area as well as in Lyon County.

Joseph Lerma, 30, of Reno, was booked November 21st into the Washoe County Detention Facility. His charges are Possession of Stolen Property and Burglary. Lerma's bail is set at \$275,000.00.

Also arrested was Alverine Skenadore, 39, of Sparks, was booked for Possession of Stolen Property. Her bail was \$2,500.
