Foundation 36, a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving historic sites in Nevada, has given a grant of \$2,500.00 to the K-9 unit to be used for training and an additional \$1,000.00 to the Marine 9 unit which patrols the waters of Incline Village at North Lake Tahoe.

The money has been granted out of appreciation to the efforts made by Deputies and staff at the Incline Substation in support of the cultural heritage programs at the Thunderbird Lodge Museum Estate. The K-9 units and Marine 9 are seen patrolling both land and waters around this historic site as well as the rest of Incline Village and the community is grateful, according to a letter from Bill Watson, the Manager and Curator of the Thunderbird Lodge.

“We do have a great team working Incline and are very thankful of the generosity exhibited by the foundation,” states Sheriff Mike Haley. “Our K-9’s are often called upon by other agencies to assist. Recently they were assisting the Nevada Highway Patrol when two of the dogs hit on a scent during a vehicle search. That hit landed 16 lbs. of marijuana being confiscated. Our dogs are an incredible asset to the local law enforcement community.”
