UNSOLVED HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

CASE- WC03-8336

DETAILS- ON JULY 25, 2003, THE DECOMPOSING REMAINS OF A BLACK FEMALE ADULT WERE DISCOVERED ON A DIRT ROAD ALONG THE FRONTAGE ROAD IN MOGUL, NEVADA, WEST OF RENO, NEVADA. THE ROAD, WHICH RUNS ALONG INTERSTATE 80, IS ACCESS FOR SEVERAL RESIDENCES AND A STORAGE FACILITY. THE ROAD IS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE INTERSTATE.

THE BODY WAS NUDE. A WHITE METAL RING WITH SCROLLING WAS FOUND UPON THE RIGHT RING FINGER. NO CAUSE OF DEATH COULD BE DETERMINED, HOWEVER IT IS CLEAR THAT SHE DIED ELSEWHERE AND WAS DUMPED AT THIS LOCATION.

THE WOMAN WAS 5'3" TO 5'7" INCHES IN HEIGHT AND POSSIBLY BETWEEN 26 TO 36 YEARS OLD. THE WOMAN HAD THICKENED, IRREGULAR TOE NAILS THAT WERE QUITE LONG. HER TEETH WERE IN POOR CONDITION, WITH 16 MISSING. SHE HAD A HEALED FACIAL INJURY THAT CAUSED A FRACTURE TO HER NOSE AND JAW ON THE RIGHT SIDE. THIS MAY HAVE CAUSED HER FACE TO APPEAR ASYMETRICAL ON THE RIGHT SIDE.
