UNSOLVED HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

CASE- G80-0266

DETAILS- ON JULY 10, 1980, HIKERS DISCOVERED THE DECOMPOSING BODY OF KARIN SANTOS-COY, AGE 19, ALONG RED ROCK ROAD, NORTH OF RENO, NEVADA. SHE HAD BEEN REPORTED MISSING TO THE RENO POLICE DEPARTMENT AFTER DISAPPEARING ON JUNE 28, 1980. SANTOS-COY WAS LAST KNOWN TO BE AT THE RENO RODEO ATTENDING THE PERFORMANCES. SHE WAS SHOT TO DEATH AND LEFT NUDE ALONG A DIRT ROAD.

SANTOS-COY WAS SEEN TALKING WITH 2 WHITE MALES AT THE RODEO.

ONE WAS DESCRIBED AS HAVING MEDIUM LENGTH CURLY BLONDE HAIR, BAREFOOT, WITH CASUAL CLOTHING, ABOUT 5'10" TALL AND 130 POUNDS, AGE ESTIMATED TO BE 20-21.

THE SECOND WAS DESCRIBED AS HAVING SHORT BROWN HAIR, 5'10" TALL AND 180 POUNDS. THIS SUBJECT ALSO HAD NO SHOES ON AND WAS DRESSED IN A T-SHIRT AND PANTS, AGE ESTIMATED TO BE 28-30.
