**UNSOLVED HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION**

**CASE-** K79-0041

**DETAILS-** ON NOVEMBER 02, 1979, THE SKELETAL REMAINS OF JEANNIE SMITH, AGE 17, WERE FOUND IN LEMMON VALLEY, NEVADA, NORTH OF RENO. SHE DIED AS A RESULT OF BLUNT FORCE TRAUMA. HER REMAINS WERE FOUND IN A SHALLOW GRAVE ABOUT 1 MILE FROM WHERE JULIA WOODWARD HAD BEEN DISCOVERED IN MARCH OF THE SAME YEAR.

SMITH WAS LAST SEEN ON OCTOBER 28, 1978, AT THE CIRCUS-CIRCUS HOTEL IN RENO, NEVADA. SHE HAD BEEN A REPORTED MISSING PERSON FROM RENO POLICE.
