2 Arrested In Incline for Burglary

On November 7, 2007, at 1050 p.m., Deputies were dispatched to an alarm at Porter's Ski and Sport at 855 Tahoe Blvd. in Incline Village. Upon arrival the deputies discovered evidence of a fresh burglary.

A person by the name of Donald Stratton was located loitering nearby. Further investigation linked Stratton to the Burglary. Stratton was arrested and charged with Burglary (conspiracy) and Burglary (accessory) with \$2,500.00 bail.

As the deputies were processing the scene for evidence a second subject was observed loitering at a nearby apartment complex. He was contacted and was identified as Zachary Coots. He made admissions linking himself to the burglary at Porters. Coots was arrested and charged with Burglary, Burglary (conspiracy) and Grand larceny with \$8,500 bail.

Further evidence was discovered that linked these two suspects to other burglaries in the area. A number of stolen items were recovered.
