## DRIVERS:

-  Slow down, stay extra alert.
-  Come to a full stop and check both ways at stop signs and red lights.
-  Watch for kids at intersections, on medians and on curbs.
-  When a school bus stops with lights flashing or the stop sign raised, cars going both directions must stop.
-  Focus on the road. Using a cellular phone while driving is against the law and dangerous.
-  Expect the unexpected.



## STUDENTS:

-  Distracted walking can be just as dangerous as distracted driving.
-  Cross the street at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks.
-  Never run out into the streets or cross between parked cars.
-  Always walk in front of the bus where the driver can see you.
-  Refrain from horseplay and remain in a group while waiting for the school bus.
