Deputies Arrest Three in Burglary Case

WHEN: Original call May 4, at approximately 10:00pm.

WHERE: Began at residence in South Reno and led to residence on Turbine Street in Lemmon Valley and Heights Street in North West Reno.

Washoe County Deputies responded to a call Sunday Night, May 4th at approximately 10:00pm of a burglary in progress at a residence in South Reno. Deputies arrive on scene to locate and arrest Doriane Densen-Jacobs (#08-9301) as she attempted to escape through a window. William Platt (#08-9300) was located inside the residence and arrested without incident while a third suspect got away from deputies.

These arrests led detectives to obtain 2 search warrants; one at a home on Turbine St. in Lemmon Valley and one on Heights Drive in North West Reno which were executed May 5. Numerous items of stolen property were recovered including antique saddles, antique porcelain figurines, firearms, burglary tools, radios and numerous items of drug paraphernalia.

During the search of these homes, detectives also located the third suspect and arrested Aaron Noble (#08-9365) who was booked into the Washoe County jail at approximately 2:45pm on May 5th. These arrests and the recovered property are expected to be connected to many burglary cases in the county as well as city limits.

“Detectives and Patrol Deputies worked hand in hand to apprehend these suspects,” states Sheriff Michael Haley, “This was an exceptional job and a great example of effective policing.”

Densen-Jacobs, Doriane of Reno was charged with:

Burglary, obstructing a peace officer, unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of methamphetamine, unlawful possession of burglary tools, and possession of a dangerous drug without prescription. Bail set at \$8,935.

Platt, William Heath Jr. of Reno was charged with:

Burglary, obstructing a peace officer, unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of methamphetamine, unlawful possession of burglary tools, possession of controlled substance with intent to sell. Bail set at \$10,435.

Noble Aaron Lloyd, of Reno was charged with:

3 counts of possession stolen property, burglary, unlawful use of drug paraphernalia, and contempt of court. Bail set at \$13,185.
